About Speaker

Hj Abdul Murad commenced his career with the Royal Malaysian Police in 1973. Whilst in service he went to read law at the International Islamic University ("IIUM") and graduated with a Degree in Bachelor of Laws (Hons) in 1993. He resumed service and served as Prosecutor at the Magistrates & Sessions Court in Kuala Lumpur. Thereafter he went on to pursue degree in Masters in Comparative Laws (MCL) graduating in 1995 and later went on to commence Post Graduate Diploma study in Shariah Law & Practice.

He left Government Service and was admitted as an Advocates & Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya in October 1995. He has been in continuous active legal practice for the last 20 years, and is a principal partner at Messrs Zain Megat & Murad. His areas of practice are mainly Corporate Legal Advisory, Conveyancing, Commercial Contracts, Banking Security Documentation, and he also provides corporate legal advice to several private & public companies.

Hj Abdul Murad served as Chairman, Conveyancing Practice Committee ("CPC") of the Bar Council Malaysia for two consecutive terms (2010/2011) and (2011/2012). Now he is now Deputy Co-Chair of CPC having been re-elected for the last three consecutive terms. He is also a member of the Solicitors Remuneration Order Enforcement Committee.

Amongst others Hj Abdul Murad is also a member of PEMUDAH Focus Group Registering Property (a Special Task Force under Prime Minister's Department) monitoring efficiency issues and improvement of public service delivery system intended to enhance Malaysia's competitiveness in the business environment. He also sits as a panel member of the Legal Profession Qualifying Board Malaysia for Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination and was appointed to be a member of Solicitor's Cost Committee pursuant to section 113 of the Legal Profession Act 1976.

Hj Abdul Murad is also currently one of the Presidents for Home Buyers Tribunal appointed by the Minister, Ministry of Urban Wellbeing, Housing & Local Government on 1 Jan 2013.
