Tan Kim Soon obtained his Bachelor of Economics Degree (Honours-Lower Division) from the University of Malaya in 1979 on a full bank scholarship. Through part-time studies, he completed the Bachelor of Laws Degree (Honours-Upper Division) from the University of London in 1992. He further completed the Certificate in Legal Practice Examination in 1993.

He commenced pupillage with Messrs Shook Lin & Bok in January 1996 and was admitted as an Advocate & Solicitor in October 1996. He commenced his own law practice in November 1996 under the name of Messrs Tan Kim Soon & Co. He practices all areas of the law, except criminal law.

He was a top student in school and was amongst the top 3% of graduates graduating with the highest mark in the Company Law paper. His achievements have been aired on TV2 under a motivational programme. He undertakes cases in Court which is one of the first of its kind in the country, some of which have been reported in the law reports.

He is a member of Bar Council's Conveyancing Practice Committee. He has represented Bar Council Malaysia in meetings with the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Ministry of Natural Resources, Insolvency Department, Jabatan Ukur Dan Pemetaan Malaysia and Attorney General's Chambers on proposed changes to laws relating to property and property management in Malaysia.

He has also attended meetings on behalf of Bar Council Malaysia with the Land Offices, Lembaga Hasil Dalam Negeri, Bank Negara Malaysia and Association of Banks in Malaysia to resolve outstanding issues affecting the Legal Profession.

He had written articles on property related issues which have been published in the New Straits Times, The Sun, iproperty and Utusan Konsumer.
