Talk Outline:

It is a common scenario faced by many practitioners of family law, where clients found themselves in a quandary despite having been granted a court order in their favour. Many were unable to assert their rights, especially during the COVID-19 pandemic.

This talk will give an overview of the application for an order of committal, and highlight common pitfalls to avoid – whether acting for the applicants or the alleged contemnors. While the examples will be from the area of Family Law, the procedural session is of general application in civil matters.
