Afifuddin bin Ahmad Hafifi spearheads the Criminal Justice Department as a Senior Partner in the esteemed, Messrs Salehuddin Saidin & Associates. His career as a prolific and illustrious criminal defence lawyer began with Messrs Salehuddin Saidin and Associates in 2008 when he started as an Associate. Within a short period, he managed to build a reputation as a leading expert in criminal litigation. Bold and experienced, he is not one to shy away from challenges and has dealt with numerous complex criminal matters involving Capital Punishment offences namely under the Dangerous Drug Act, Penal Code and more. Apart from that, he regularly deals with highly complex and high profile corruption cases.

His contribution to society is also well recognized through his pro-bono cases as a Court-appointed lawyer in criminal matters. His impact as a part-time law lecturer at University Teknologi Mara (UiTM) under the Bachelors of Laws remains impactful as it helps create a realistic understanding of the legal practice, especially in criminal matters.
