"Certain legal industries and judicial systems around the world have begun to utilise the use of AI tools. There are many ways how these AI tools have been used including (1) supporting sentencing decisions. (Malaysia), (2) Harm Assessment Risk Tool (UK), (3) Transcribing Court Hearings in real-time (Singapore), (4) Robot judge for adjudicating small claims (Estonia) and (5) Giving legal advice, approving pensions (China, China/Mexico/Russia). Robo lawyering or artificial intelligence is set to change the legal industry and judicial systems. We seek to discuss the possibility of introducing a robo-legal advisory service that complies all the requirement set for a human legal expert under the Legal Profession Act 1976 and recognised to represent clients in a court of law under the Courts of Judicature Act 1964."
