The Selangor Bar had discussion addressing and resolving the following issues:

| Issue 1                | Written Reply to the representation sent by lawyers.<br>In order to expedite the process, Selangor Bar suggested that PPN’s office to have a special e-mail dedicated to receive the representation.   |
| Decision/Clarification | PPN informed that for every representation received, PPN’s office will immediately issue out reply acknowledging receipt of the same.<br>Lawyers may now send their representation to PPN’s office via email at <a href="mailto:selangorpendakwaan@agc.gov.my">selangorpendakwaan@agc.gov.my</a> |
| Issue 2                | Delay in producing Investigation Papers by the Investigating Officer to the DPP in court have prolonged the waiting hours of the members in court.   |
| Decision/Clarification | PPN will raise this issue with PDRM.   |
| Issue 3                | DPP introduced cautioned statement under Section 112 CPC to impeach the accused or discredit the accused before the explanation from the accused is obtained in a trial through the Investigating Officer.   |
| Decision/Clarification | PPN clarified that the DPP is directed not to use the recorded statement of the accused as evidence in a trial. The DPP will be reminded that this practice is not permitted.  |
